

- You can also enjoy an unforgettable day with your family and friends horseback riding, parasailing, jet-skiing, or visiting its private aquarium.





















SLS Baha Mar 1DAY

- Make your way back on board for a candlelit dinner by Chef Marco









Famous among the rich - this elegant culinary experience offers more than an outstanding dinner, it's the epitome of fine Bahamian cuisine




Ocean Atlas Underwater Sculptures
